Psychology is generally defined as the science of behavior and mental processes and the application of the resulting findings to the solution of problems. Psychology differs from sociology, in part, by studying the behavior of individuals rather than the behavior of the groups themselves. The root of the word psychology (psyche) means "soul" or "spirit" in Greek, and psychology was sometimes considered a study of the soul in a religious sense of this term.

The first person to call himself a "psychologist", Wilhelm Wundt, opened the first psychological laboratory in 1879. Until about the end of the 19 century, psychology was regarded as a branch of philosophy. With the work of Wundt and William James, the field of psychology was slowly established as a science independent of philosophy. Few universities, journals, or researchers today treat psychology as a branch of philosophy, but there is much disagreement as to whether it should be considered an experimental science.

Today psychologists work in cooperation, and sometimes in competition, with psychiatrists who are medical doctors specializing in mental health issues.
